

"One photo, one story"



The Rialto Cinema in Limassol, was built in 1933 and was the first modern cinema in Cyprus, by the standards of that period. During the same time, it was acquired by the N.P. Lanitis company and quickly became a point of reference for the cultural, artistic and social activity of Limassol society, since in addition to being a cinema, it was also a place for theatrical performances, concerts and other social events.

Around the mid-1980s, it was forced to close its doors, due to the effects of the Turkish invasion of 1974 and subsequently, the relevant drastic changes brought about by the introduction and development of TV industry and subsequently the extensive use of video.

The disputes of the local "criminal team" of that time were centred on Heroes' Square — where the Rialto is located — and so the area became the most unpopular area of Limassol. Additionally, the imposition of entertainment tax, the opening of the Pattichion Municipal Theatre in 1987, and the further dominance of video, which resulted to the final blow to the local cinema industry, led to the closure of the Rialto. N.P. Lanitis Ltd, sold it to the Limassol Cooperative Savings Bank in 1991.

In the 2000s, the cultural organisation "Rialto Theatre" was founded, which undertook the renovation of the property and its management.
