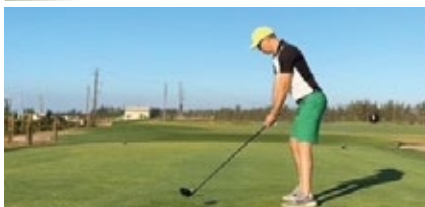

Important infrastructure projects at the University of Cyprus by Cybarco Contracting

The University of Cyprus has signed a contract with Cybarco Contracting for a new important project, which includes the study, construction and maintenance of the infrastructure projects - Phase B on the University Campus. The contract was signed on behalf of the University of Cyprus by the Rector Professor Tasos Christofides and on behalf of Cybarco Contracting by Mr. Nicolas Lanitis, Chairman of the Board of Directors.

The project is a decisive step towards the implementation of the University's strategic vision, to make its campus a model of a sustainable, green and smart city. It is also a step towards the implementation of modern approaches and applications to energy and environmental issues, with a direct positive impact on society.

The completion of the project will serve, among other things, access to the construction sites of the new student halls and research centres of the University. In parallel with the construction of pedestrian bridges, the Kalogeros River which crosses the Campus, will be highlighted, giving it a new role as an element of the natural landscape of the greater area. The project also includes the execution of all necessary electrical and mechanical infrastructure, as well as the relevant network installations, for the integrated and safe operation of the park and the road network, as well as future developments on the University campus.



The very first golf players of Limassol Greens

October 1st, 2025, has now become a milestone date for Limassol Greens. On this day, a small number of enthusiast and traditional golf players had the opportunity to be the first to step onto the grass of the Limassol Greens golf course and make the first swings, unofficially inaugurating the project's golf facilities.

The 18-hole golf course at Limassol Greens, designed by the renowned architect Cabell Robinson, is already gaining recognition within the European golf community. With a length of over 6,300 metres and tees and fairways made of Tahoma 31 grass, the course meets international championship standards.

Limassol Greens, with an investment of €400 million and a total area of 1.4 million square metres, aims to become a reference point for luxurious living, sports tourism, and sustainable development in Cyprus.

2025 is a milestone year for the project. Since September, the gradual handover of the first 74 homes – 22 villas and 52 apartments in Robin East and Robin West – has begun, marking the transition from the construction phase to the creation of a vibrant community.
